Urban Community

The overarching goal for this approach is to inspire native ownership in all three areas (school, careers, and church) with the long-term goal of a holistic, generational framework for sustainable community that can replicate and penetrate the urban community.

The message to residents from the start will be this:

We have come to help you build a sustainable, holistic community that will thrive and serve your families for generations to follow and crush the cycle of dependence.

How can we mentor and disciple you and your children to build this community to be a shining light in your city as followers of Christ in every area of your life?

Together we can build a community that will provide a safe place for your children with a school that provides a solid Christian education to equip and prepare them for employment, and a Christian church to provide a safe place for your families to grow spiritually and to worship.

Awaneness

Invite platforms such as DestiNations International, Faith Builders, Sharon Bible Institute, and others to create awareness of the service opportunities and positions that need to be filled by families, couples, singles, and empty nesters who have a passion for the success of their children, and their children's generation, in these communities.



School

The school is the greatest point of entry to build relationships with residents. Their children are their most precious earthly eternal investment. By first providing a safe place for them during the week, school becomes vital to developing trust relationships with residents. This is our opportunity to interact with the children and parents throughout the week in meaningful ways.

Careers

The focus of the business will serve the graduating students by offering apprenticeships where healthy employee-employer relationships can be modeled and taught and skills developed so the graduates can provide sustainable incomes for their families and break the cycle of generational dependency. The business would intentionally hire residents as another way to serve the city, build relationships, and introduce them to the community.

Church

The ultimate goal and the anchor of the urban community is the band of brothers. The church will serve the community to teach, mentor, and disciple residents with Biblical values in every area of life and empower residents to adapt these values to their dominant, native language and culture so they can say,
